A. Cost Breakdown

Amount must be paid in full by credit card, cashier's check or money order by the first day of class. You are responsible to let us know if there is a third-party payor such as St. Joseph Hospital or WIOA. The charge for the Nursing Assistant training program is \$1,200 but does not include the cost of books or uniforms. The \$25 application fee will be credited towards the total tuition charge.
